

BIG AND STRONG CRAFT | LESSON 3

DAVID STORY STONES

The kids will create their own pouch filled with stones, like a pouch David may have used to hold his stones. Each stone will help the kids remember a part of the Bible story! David was confident in God, and we can be confident in God, too.

DIRECTIONS

PREP

- 1. Print out printables.
- 2. Cut out stones and pouch.
- 3. Fold and punch the holes out of the pouch.
- 4. Cut arm's length pieces of yarn for each pouch.
- 5. Prepare crayons, yarn and printables for the leaders.

MAKE

- 1. Pass out each of the printables for the kids to color.
- 2. Give each kid a piece of yarn.
- 3. Show the kids how to lace the yarn through the holes on the pouch.
- 4. Tie the ends of the yarn together, creating a strap.
- 5. Place the story stones inside.
- 6. Show the kids how to store, sort, and use their stones to retell the story of David and Goliath.
