WAYS MY HANDS CAN SERVE

To help the kids remember they can choose the good habit of serving others, they will see some ways they can serve. Encourage the kids to hang it somewhere to remember some ways they can show others God's love.

DIRECTIONS

PREP

1. Print and cut out the *Serve Hands* and *Banner* printables. (1 set per child)
2. Cut one 18-inch piece and three 12-inch pieces of yarn per child.
3. Tape the 18-inch piece of yarn to the top of the banner, making the hanger.
4. Tape the 12-inch pieces of yarn along the bottom of the banner for the hands to hang.
5. Gather printable sets, tape, and crayons or markers.

MAKE

1. Explain they will be making a craft that will help them remember ways they can serve.
Serve: Helping others to show them God's love.
2. Pass out the printable sets to the kids and allow them time to color.
3. While they color, discuss the talking points and read the different prompts to help the kids discover ways they can serve. They will write their answers on the provided line.
4. They can color the back of each hand showing them serving in that way.
5. Help the kids tape each hand to their mobile.
