



STARFISH CLAPPER

Use this craft to help your child remember that just like David, they can praise and thank God when they pray. We can praise and thank God quietly or loudly! Their starfish clapper can help them make a loud noise to praise and thank God.



DIRECTIONS

PREP

1. Print out the Starfish Clapper printable.
Option: Create your own design using the printable as a guide.

DO

1. Allow your child to color the printable.
2. Help your child cut out the two starfish with the words and the one starfish without words.
3. Glue or tape the bottom of each starfish to the top of the craft stick so that the two starfish with words are facing out with the words and the one no word starfish is in the middle of the other two.
4. Glue buttons to the inside of the top arms of the two starfish with words.
5. Glue buttons to the top arms of the star fish without words on both sides.
6. Once the glue dries, show your child that when they shake the stick, the starfish hands hit together to create the "clapping" sound.

Starfish printable



Scissors



Crayons or markers



Craft stick

* Buttons, coins, bottle caps, etc.



Glue

* Things that make noise when they are hit together.

- Let's say that to God and shake your clapper to celebrate him!
