PRAYING IN COLOR

Supplies: Praying in Color worksheet, writing utensil, markers or crayons

Directions:

1. Sit and give everyone a pen. Make sure to have markers and/or crayons available.
2. Have everyone write down as many ways as they can think of to praise and thank God.
3. Encourage your child to color in as they go—giving them the freedom to artistically record their praise and thanks.

TALKING POINTS

Get together and talk about how this activity helps us think about this week's Bible story and prayer.

- That reminds me about David. He prayed to God his whole life. I bet his sheet would be filled with things.
- Let's put this paper somewhere we can see it. That way we can always have something to see when we start our prayers. We can even continue to add to it.
