



ZACCHAEUS

TODDLER CRAFT | LESSON 3

TUBE TREES

In this craft, the children will make tube trees to put Zacchaeus in. This will remind them that Zacchaeus climbed up in a tree so he could see Jesus.

DIRECTIONS

PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Print out the Zacchaeus printable.
2. Cut out each Zacchaeus from the printable.
3. Cut from the top of the craft tube down a couple inches to create branches all the way around.
4. Have craft tubes, green construction paper, scissors, tape and printables ready for the leaders.

DURING THE SERVICE

1. Give each child a craft tube. Show the children how to push their hands down on top of the tubes with flare out the strips in the tube.
2. Show them how to stand their tube up on the table.
3. Pass out green construction paper to each child. Have them crumple the paper, this will be the top of our tree.
4. With some tape place the ball of paper on the branches of the tube.
5. Give everyone a Zacchaeus and have them tape it to their trees any where they would like.
